Microsoft recognises Great Yarmouth company as an official partner

A Great Yarmouth business is celebrating being recognised by Microsoft as the small business computer specialist for this area.

CSS Computers was formally assessed by the software giant, and its staff had to pass technical exams.

Now it has passed, it means Microsoft will officially recommend CSS to small businesses.

MD Peter Green set up the business in Yarmouth 18 years ago.

It installs networks and PCs for local businesses, then maintains them and trains staff to use them.

And at the end of last year, CSS and its partner company Accountancy Solutions beat 1,000 other companies around the UK to win the Sage Circle of Excellence Award.

Peter added: “It’s been an incredible 12 months for us and proof that years of hard work do pay off. But we’re not sitting back and resting on our laurels. Our new bigger premises are giving us plenty of chance to expand, and who knows, maybe win a few more awards!”
